

CSS Positioning Cheat Sheet



position:static

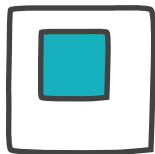
Elements fall in the normal flow of the page.
Default.

It's the non-position, position property.



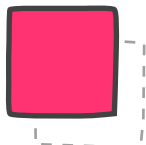
position:fixed

Elements positioned in relation to the browser.
Taken out of the flow of the page.
Ignores scrolling.



position:absolute

Elements positioned in relation to its parent element.
Taken out of the flow of the page.
Parent must be fixed, absolute, or relative.



position:relative

Shifts elements

Looks at where element would have been and shifts it from that spot.
Reserves the space where it would have been.
Great companion to absolute.

set with top / left / bottom / right

see also: **position: sticky;**
